



# SPECIAL RULES AND REGULATIONS.

## Applicable to all Divisions, and Superseding General Rules and Regulations, which are Inconsistent Therewith.

**RIGHTS OF TRAINS.**—East-bound trains have absolute right of track over West-bound trains of the same or inferior class. Trains running on double track will use right hand track.

1. **TRAIN WORK.**—Trains must be made up systematically in station order, which order will be preserved in taking or leaving cars. In loading freight it must, as far as practicable, be consolidated in full car loads and occupy the least number of cars required, irrespective of other cars having to go empty in the same direction. Conductors must observe the above in loading local freight, as well as to transfer lightly loaded cars. Agents at way stations must hold small lots of freight to load on trains instead of loading in cars at station. Agents at district terminals will transfer and consolidate the contents of lightly loaded cars. Local Freight trains will stop, on signal, at all stations.

2. Not more than two engines must be coupled to one Passenger train. If more power is required, trains must be divided.

3. **SPEED OF TRAINS.**—Trains must not exceed schedule time within the corporate limits of towns or cities, and all trains when approaching stations where switch engines are employed, must be under full control, expecting to find main line blocked.

Special Passenger trains and Light Engines must not exceed the running time of First Class trains, nor Extra Freight and Work trains that of Third Class trains. Class 113 engines will not exceed twenty-five miles per hour.

4. **PASSENGERS ON FREIGHT TRAINS.**—Passengers will be carried only on freight trains designated in Division Special Rules subject to the conditions of General Rule No. 174. Passengers taking freight trains should be informed that cabooses will not be pulled up to platform to take or deliver Passengers or Baggage.

5. **AIR-BRAKES.**—The automatic air-brake must be used on Passenger trains, and on Broad Gauge Freight trains having cars so equipped, and pressure retaining valves must be applied before descending heavy grades. In Broad Gauge Freight trains, when only a portion of the cars are so equipped, these must be trained next to the engine, and care exercised in taking up slack of train when reducing speed.

The air hose when not coupled between cars must be coupled to dummy coupling provided for that purpose. See Question No. 1, Air-Brake Instructions.

Straight air will be used on Narrow Gauge Mixed and Freight trains. Air-brakes must be tested on trains before leaving terminal stations, as required by Air-Brake Instructions.

When double-headers are run the air must be coupled to both engines, and forward engineman must operate the air-brake. Pushing engines must always have air-brake coupled.

**CROSSING RULES.**—Special rules governing grade crossings do not cancel Rule 94, General Regulations, requiring all trains and engines to stop at such crossings, except S. F. & Colo. & So. crossings No. 1 and No. 2, and A. T. & S. F. No. 5, where it is not expected that trains will make the usual crossing stop when signals are set at safety, but must run slowly with trains under full control.

Before entering upon Union Depot tracks at Denver and Pueblo, all trains and light engines will come to **FULL STOP** and receive proper signal from Switch Tender before proceeding.

### EXPLANATION OF CHARACTERS.

Letters at right of station names indicate telegraph call. Figures under each district and train indicate mileage of district and time used by trains in passing over the same.

### THE FOLLOWING SPECIAL RULES SUPERSEDE ALL GENERAL AND SPECIAL RULES INCONSISTENT THEREWITH WITHIN THE LIMITS NAMED :

#### FIRST DIVISION.

7. **TRAIN WORK.**—Local Trains Nos. 77 and 78 on First District; Nos. 67 and 68 on Second District; Nos. 163 and 164 on Third District, and Nos. 167 and 168 on Fourth District, will do way work.

8. **SPEED OF TRAINS.**—FREIGHT TRAINS will not exceed twenty-five miles per hour, or schedule time.

#### CROSSING RULES.

9. **FIRST DISTRICT.**—At S. F. and C. & S. Crossing No. 1, 3.7 miles from Denver.—Colo. & So. and A. T. & S. F. trains from Denver have right to cross ahead of D. & R. G. trains in either direction. D. & R. G. trains in either direction have right to cross ahead of Colo. & So. and A. T. & S. F. trains toward Denver. At Circle Crossing.—Circle R. R. trains from Denver have right to cross ahead of D. & R. G. trains in either direction. D. & R. G. trains in either direction have the right to cross ahead of Circle R. R. trains toward Denver. At Colo. & So. Crossing No. 1, on Ft. Logan Branch.—Colo. & So. trains from Denver have right to cross ahead of D. & R. G. trains in either direction. D. & R. G. trains in either direction have right to cross ahead of Colo. & So. trains toward Denver. M. P. crossing at mile 119.2.—D. & R. G. trains from Pueblo have the right to cross ahead of M. P. trains in either direction.—M. P. trains in either direction have the right to cross ahead of D. & R. G. trains toward Pueblo. C. R. I. & P. trains, when crossing double tracks at Roswell and Colorado Springs must be protected by flagmen.

SECOND DISTRICT.—At crossings Nos. 3 and 4, A. T. & S. F. trains from Pueblo have the right to cross ahead of D. & R. G. trains in either direction. D. & R. G. trains in either direction, have the right to cross ahead of A. T. & S. F. trains towards Pueblo.

Between Denver and Littleton.

Pikeview and Kelker.

#### SECOND DIVISION.

10. **TRAIN WORK.**—Freight trains 221 and 222 for N. G. work between Salida and Leadville, 223 and 224 will do way work between Salida and Minturn, 225 and 226 will do way work between Minturn and Aspen, 63 and 66 between Minturn and Grand Junction.

11. **PASSENGERS ON FREIGHT TRAINS.**—Passengers will be carried on trains 62, 63 and 66 between Minturn and Grand Junction, and 225 and 226 between Minturn and Aspen.

12. **SPEED OF TRAINS.**—Passenger trains will not exceed schedule time between Brown's Canon and Nathrop, between Pine Creek and Twin Lakes, between Tenn. Pass and Minturn, between Leadville and Malta or between Dotsero and Glenwood. Freight trains will not exceed twelve miles per hour on descending grades between Leadville and Malta, Tenn. Pass and Minturn and Bird's Eye and Dillon. Between other points they will not exceed schedule time, except by special order. Speed over Grand River bridge at Glenwood must not exceed six miles per hour. All trains must keep not less than ten minutes apart in running through Tennessee Pass Tunnel, and will use five minutes in tunnel in either direction. Light engines will use one hour and ten minutes running time from Tennessee Pass to Minturn. The Junction switch at east end of Grand Junction yard has two switch lights and targets on it, the higher light and target will indicate position of switch for Rio Grande Junction Line trains, and the lower light and target, position of switch for Third Division trains. All trains will come to a full stop before crossing over this switch. D. & R. G. trains will use Colorado Midland tracks to and from the depot at New Castle and Rule 94 must be observed at the C. M. switches.

13. Conductors will invariably require the air-brakes to be tested, cylinders and connections examined, before leaving district terminals, or where cars are set off or taken on.

14. **WYES.**—The Wyes at Malta and Glenwood must not be blocked with cars. Trains must not side-track on Colo. & So. Wye at Buena Vista.

15. **CROSSING RULES.**—D. & R. G. trains will not be required to stop at Colorado & Southern crossing one mile west of Nathrop, but will reduce speed to ten miles per hour. A gate has been erected and is to remain over Colorado & Southern track, except when the trains of that line are using the crossing. Trainmen and enginemen will keep close watch for this signal, and when red is displayed will come to a full stop. At night when light is out, trains will stop and be governed by Rule 94, as heretofore.

Colorado Midland Crossing at M. P. 391.5.—Colorado Midland trains toward Aspen have the right to cross ahead of D. & R. G. trains in either direction. D. & R. G. trains in either direction have the right to cross ahead of Colorado Midland trains from Aspen. Colorado Midland Crossing at New Castle.—Colorado Midland trains going West have the right to cross ahead of D. & R. G. trains in either direction. D. & R. G. trains in either direction have the right to cross ahead of Colorado Midland trains going east. Colorado Midland Crossing, Strawberry Branch, Aspen.—D. & R. G. trains eastbound or descending grade will have right to cross ahead of Colorado Midland trains in either direction, and Colorado Midland trains in either direction will have the right to cross ahead of D. & R. G. trains westbound or ascending the grade.

#### THIRD DIVISION.

16. **TRAIN WORK.**—Freight trains 301, 302, 327, and 328 will do way work.

17. **SPEED OF TRAINS.**—Trains on mountain or canon sections must not exceed schedule time under any circumstances, and must not exceed eight miles per hour between Sapinero and Lake Junction. On other portions of the Division passenger trains will not exceed thirty miles per hour and mixed and freight trains, eighteen miles per hour.

All trains approaching Marshall Pass station will reduce speed to four miles per hour at first switch. West-bound trains will take siding. When using tracks other than designated, it must be done under danger signals. The Junction switch at east end of Grand Junction yard has two switch lights and targets on it, the higher light and target will indicate position of switch for Rio Grande Junction Line trains, and the lower light and target, position of switch for Third Division trains. All trains will come to a full stop before crossing over this switch.

18. **CROSSING RULES.**—Colo. & So. Crossing No. 13, at Gunnison. Colo. & So. trains going west have the right to cross ahead of D. & R. G. trains in either direction. D. & R. G. trains in either direction have the right to cross ahead of Colo. & So. trains going east.

19. Conductors will invariably require the air-brakes to be tested, cylinders and connections examined, before leaving district terminals, or where cars are set off or taken on.

20. Train 69, between Sargent and Gunnison, 311 and 312 between Gunnison and Cimarron, will carry passengers.

#### FOURTH DIVISION.

21. **TRAIN WORK.**—Trainmen must not uncouple cars on grade between Chama and Cumbres without first testing hand-brakes and knowing that they will hold.

22. **PASSENGERS ON FREIGHT TRAINS.**—Passengers may be carried on trains 441 and 442 between Alamosa and Chama, and on trains 451 and 452 between Chama and Durango.

23. **SPEED OF TRAINS.**—All trains must consume twenty minutes between Rockwood and Animas River bridge. Trains on mountain or canon sections must not exceed schedule time under any circumstances. Trains must not exceed schedule time from Cumbres to Chama, and from Barranca to Embudo. On other portions of the Division passenger trains will not exceed thirty miles per hour, and mixed and freight trains fifteen miles per hour.

No train will leave Denver without special order or clearance ticket. Second and third class trains will not leave 11th Street, West Denver, without special order or clearance ticket.

All trains will leave Denver without special order or clearance ticket. Second and third class trains will not leave 15th Street, West Denver, without special order or clearance ticket. All trains and engines will approach cross-overs at Military Junction, Overland Park, 6th Ave., 11th Ave. and Larimer St., West Denver, under full control, expecting to find Suburban or other trains using same. Double track between 6th St. and Union Depot, Denver, is used as joint track by D. & R. G. and D. L. & G. passenger trains. ALL trains will make the usual crossing stop before passing cross-over at 6th St.

Regular meeting point on double track for Nos. 1 and 24, 5 and 22, 29 and 78, 16 and 77, 82 and 77, 10 and 63, between Denver and Littleton, are not indicated by full-faced type.

Denver, Lakewood and Golden Electric Railway crosses at Curtis Street. Transfer trains to and from B. & M. R. R. cross between 7th and 11th Streets. ALL trains must be under perfect control and speed reduced before passing over these crossings.
