In addition to the flag stops shown, trains will stop on flag at Broom, Union Pacific-Southern Pacific Interchange, Midway, View, Clays, Nerva, Woods, South Perry, Davis, South Brigham, Bristol, Harper, Calls Fort, Crystal Springs, Madsen, Pioneer, Beaton, Ukon, Beaver Dam, Summit, Kidman, Farrell, Petersboro, Hills, West Hyrum, Anderson, Humphries, South Logan, Greenville, Mack, Carson, Empey, Bert, North Cache High School, Idaline, Whitney, Beckstead and South Preston.

All trains will make regular stop at Second North, Logan.

Automobile coaches will stop on flag to pick up passengers, or will stop to discharge passengers upon request at any point on the high-way outside of city limits. Within city limits coaches will stop at points designated by coach stop signs.
